

Cooperation between CIRME and SKUP

AGREEMENT about an INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION

representing the Scandinavian Evaluation of Laboratory Equipment for Primary Health Care,
SKUP.



The agreement between CIRME and SKUP was signed March 18th 2009. CIRME and SKUP undertake to promote and encourage scientific and academic collaboration including the translation of SKUP reports and summaries. Primarily, CIRME will publish an English and Italian version of the SKUP-summaries on their web-site <http://users.unimi.it/cirme>. CIRME is allowed to translate SKUP-reports to Italian. CIRME should state the origin of the SKUP-reports and provide a link to the SKUP website (www.skup.org). SKUP has no responsibility for the Italian translations.

In particular the research activity will be carried out in the field of evaluation reports on various laboratory equipments for primary health care, with the purpose of promoting and developing research programs in the field of standardisation in Laboratory Medicine.

Moreover, SKUP and CIRME could interact in performing common evaluations of laboratory equipment for primary health care, following uniform evaluation protocols. Such activities will be ruled by separate research agreement, case by case.
